Tournament regulations

1. Name of the tournament:

Future Cup 2011

2. Organiser:

FC Budapest

3. Place:

Training ground of MLTC, H-1165 Budapest. Bökényföldi út 27.

4. Date:

18-20. August 2010 (Thursday-Saturday)

5. Age:

U11 (born after the 1st January 2001)

6. Duration of each game::

1x18 min. (1st qualifying round), 2 x 12 min. (2nd qualifying round), and 2x15 min. (play-offs)

7. Playing area:

60 x 35 meter, natural grass,

8. Goals:

5 x 2 meter

9. Ball size: 4

10. Penalty

Penalty spot: 9 meter from the goal

11. Players:

6 + 1 (max. 5 substitutes)

12. Awarding prizes:

trophy, medals, best player, top scorer, best goalkeeper

13. Player Eligibility: All players born in the year 2001 are eligible to play. Each player must possess a valid player's pass, identity card or passport. The tournament organisers will carry out a check.

14. A) Rankings of Group Matches: 1) points 2) superior goal difference 3) higher number of goals scored 4) the match result against each other 5) penalty kicks

14. B) Finals: should the semi-finals end in a draw, there will be a penalty shoot-out according to FIFA regulations.

15. Substitutes: Rolling substitutes is allowed. Substitutions are to be made from the halfway line and only when play has stopped. The substitution is to be indicated to the referee.

16. Back Pass to the goalkeeper: The back pass rule does apply.

17. Offside: No offside rules applies.

18. Goal kick is to be kicked from any point within the goal area. Goal kick cannot be taken by throwing.

19. Throw-in cannot be kicked.

20. Distance for Free-Kicks: Distance of opposing team when the ball is stationary: 6 metres

21. Punishments:

- Yellow Card: 2 minutes' suspension

- Red Card: Sending-off, but not suspended for the following match

According to the seriousness of the foul, the player can also be suspended for the rest of the tournament.

22. Various: The tournament organisers have the final say on all cases not listed in the regulations.
